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## REQUIREMENTS

**Entries Due:  
5:00 p.m. (CST) January 10, 2007**

### Judging Criteria

Each entry in the FAB Awards program is judged for the success with which the project has met its individual requirements and exhibits a Fresh, Artistic, and Brilliant approach to interior design. Entries are weighted individually – not in competition with each other. Because of the number of entries, it is incumbent upon the submitter to indicate to the jury the category within which the submission should be assessed.

It is necessary to explain to the jury the characteristics that distinguish your entry to assure the specificity of the jury's evaluation. Any lengthy written descriptions of factors already clear from your graphic presentation should be avoided. All projects will be evaluated on the information contained in the completed submission package. Jurors will not visit the site.

Submissions should demonstrate design resolution or advancement, societal advancement, technical advancement, and/or environmental advancement. Submissions that are an interior renovation or restoration should demonstrate skill, sensitivity and thoughtfulness in preservation, restoration, or the alternative reuse of existing interior spaces regardless of their original architectural intentions.

The authorship of each project will remain concealed throughout the deliberations of the jury. If the authorship is revealed on any of the photos, plans, slides, or narrative, the jury may choose to disqualify the entry.

### Submission Requirements

#### PowerPoint Presentation

JPEG file format for all images, no images larger than 72 dpi with a maximum resolution of 1024 x 768 pixels. The first image shall be that of the floor plan, and then we ask for 5-10 images of the completed project. All backgrounds are to be white or black for all slides. The final slide shall be a complete list of all furniture vendors, major materials and manufacturers used on the project. Check your CDs to ensure a complete submission.

- Submit exterior images only if relevant to the overall interior design of the project.
- Interior renovation/restoration projects: Include images of the pre-existing space/conditions.
- One PowerPoint presentation per project.
- Each entrant must submit 6 completed submission packages to be passed on to each jury member, (6 Compact Disks).
- Please provide one printed copy of all slides from the PowerPoint presentation.
- Each CD must be labeled with the registration number and category.

#### Each PowerPoint presentation to include the following information:

- Name and location of project
- Category that the submission is being entered
- Contractors and major consultants
- Define this project as Fresh, Artistic and Brilliant
- Goals of the design team/client
- Execution of design solution
- Environmental design/detailing
- Definition of design problems and constraints

#### High resolution image

One publication-quality JPEG image of the completed project must be submitted in high resolution (minimum of 3000 x 2000 pixels recommended). This should be included on one of the CDs along with the PowerPoint presentation, and this CD labeled "High-Res".
